

If you are interested in possibly exhibiting at the Richmond Art Center, please submit the following:

- ☆ A current resume, listing solo and group exhibitions, education, teaching or professional experience, commissions, bibliography, etc.,
- ☆ An artist's statement (suggested length two paragraphs to one page), which addresses your intentions as an artist.
- ☆ If you are submitting a proposal for an installation, please also include an outline noting your spatial needs
- ☆ Include a disk with 20 quality, digital images of your work. Each image must be labeled with the following: Artist's name, Title of piece, date, media and dimensions of the work. **Do not submit original artwork**
- ☆ SASE **It is not our policy to return submitted materials** but if you include a SASE we will send it back to you after the curatorial committee has reviewed it.

Submissions are reviewed by the curatorial committee on a quarterly basis and response to your submission can take from 6-12 months. We will notify you if we have decided to include your work in an upcoming show, or if we can not accommodate your work. Sometimes we find a proposal very interesting but have no immediate openings in our exhibition schedule. With the artist's permission we will keep you on file in the event of a vacancy.

Additional exhibition opportunities at the Richmond Art Center include

Juried exhibitions. Traditionally we have had two annual juried exhibitions: *Bay Area Selections* and an exhibition featuring artists who live, work, or have studios in West Contra Costa.

Holiday Arts Festival -Annual December RAC benefit. An artist may also consider donating a work to this fundraiser auction which is a great way to introduce your work and yourself to community members and collectors.
